

PRIVACY POLICY

XMP Ltd, the Company is registered under the laws of Hong Kong ("We") are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy (together with our terms of use available at <https://xmotionpictures.io> ("Website") and any other documents referred to on it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting the Website, you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We will collect and process the following data about you:

Information you give us. This is information about you that you give us by filling in forms on the Website <https://xmotionpictures.io> or by corresponding with us by phone, e-mail or otherwise. The information you give us may include your name, address, e-mail address and phone number, financial and credit card information, personal description and photograph

Information we collect about you. With regard to each of your visits to our site we will automatically collect the following information:

- technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) address used to connect your computer to the Internet, your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform;
- information about your visit, including the full Uniform Resource Locators (URL), clickstream to, through and from our site (including date and time), products you viewed or searched for, page response times, download errors, length of visits to certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), methods used to browse away from the page, and any phone number used to call our customer service number.

Information we receive from other sources. We are working closely with third parties (including, for example, business partners, sub-contractors in technical, payment and delivery services, advertising networks, analytics providers, search information providers, credit reference agencies) who may provide us information about you.

COOKIES

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

When you access the XMP Site, the companies may place small text files called cookies or pixel tags on your computer or other device. They only hold a modest amount of data specific to you and the website.

These files are used to:

- Allow access for a user to login and stay logged in as they browse from page to page;
- Retain customer information;
- Customize of our platform and services, all content and advertising in order to improve our customers' experience;
- Measure marketing effectiveness;
- Collect information about your computer or other devices in order to reduce risk, help protect against fraud;
- We use both session and persistent cookies when you access our website or content. Session cookies stay on your browser and retain your information only while you are logged in to the Site. Persistent cookies have a designated lifespan and remain in a browser until the period elapses or the cookie is manually deleted. Persistent cookies enable our Site to remember users even after they close a browser.

USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

You represent and acknowledges that we use information held about you in the following ways:

Information you give to us – the XMP Team will use this information:

- i. To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;
- ii. To provide you with information about other goods and services we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about;
- iii. To provide you, or permit selected third parties to provide you, with information about goods or services we feel may interest you.
- iv. To notify you about changes to our service;
- v. To ensure that content from our site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

Information we collect about you – the XMP Team will use this information:

- i. To administer our site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- ii. To improve our site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- iii. To allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so;
- iv. As part of our efforts to keep our site safe and secure;
- v. To measure or understand the effectiveness of advertising we serve to you and others, and to deliver relevant advertising to you;
- vi. To make suggestions and recommendations to you and other users of our site about goods or services that may interest you or them.

Information we receive from other sources – the XMP Team will combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you and (depending on the types of information we receive) use it as described above.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

You agree that XMP Ltd has the right to share your personal information with:

1. Any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries.
2. Selected third parties including:
 - i. Business partners, suppliers and sub-contractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with them or you;
 - ii. Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site;
 - iii. Fraud and crime prevention agencies for the purpose of assessing the risk of crime, fraud and money laundering and this is a condition of us entering into any contract with you.

We will disclose your personal information to third parties:

1. As required by law.
2. In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we will disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets.
3. If XMP Ltd, the Company, or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
4. If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply XMP Token Sale Terms and Conditions and other agreements; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of XMP Ltd, the Company, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection money laundering prevention and credit risk reduction.
5. To ensure that we can successfully seek to complete our Token Sale and to meet our legal and contractual obligations to you related to the Token Sale.
6. To avoid crime, money laundering and the risk of fraud.
7. To ensure that we have relevant information on persons wishing to contribute to our Token Sale.
8. To ensure that the underlying network that will be developed pursuant to the Token Sale and/ or on which the Tokens are intended to be usable has sufficient and relevant information in order to support you and your use of the Tokens.
9. In order to provide relevant information to regulators, government agencies and banks that may request information on the Token Sale.

HOW YOUR PERSONAL DATA IS STORED

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside Hong Kong. All information you provide to us is stored on our and our partners performing know-your-client services servers.

It may be processed by staff operating outside Hong Kong who works for us or for one of our suppliers. This includes staff engaged in, among other things, the fulfilment of your order, the processing of your payment details and the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this policy.
